

STOMA ACCESSORY PRODUCT FORMULARY

Introduction

Stoma care products and accessory products are a considerable spend for CCG's in our area. As part of the current stoma pathway there is a work being done to ensure that all stoma patients are reviewed annually once their post-operative pathway has finished. This also fits in and achieves a standard set out in the Patient Agenda (DM).

All new stoma patients are reviewed regularly during their post-operative follow up and support, and this provides a frequent opportunity to review and appraise their products during a time when a lot of changes can occur.

Information and Guidance about the formulary

- This accessory product formulary was developed in 2015 by 2 East Kent Stoma Nurse Specialists and approved by the East Kent Prescribing Group.
- Products chosen are based on what we know to be both clinically and cost effective.
- This formulary is for *accessory products only*; it does not include stoma pouches as these (pouches) are a directive from the stoma care nurse specialist who has worked with the individual to ensure they are in the most suitable product available.
- This formulary is based around **PrescQIPP** which is an NHS programme supporting evidence based, quality prescribing.
- As stoma nurse specialists, we are best placed to be able to advise patients, GPs and CCGs what is the most clinically *and* cost effective product of choice for an individual.
- Not all patients will require an accessory product.
- An annual clinic review of a patient with a stoma will dictate if an accessory product is required and historic accessory items may be changed to formulary products after discussion to make sensible choices. (i.e. sore skin, excessive losses, pancaking etc).
- The formulary will act as a guide to stoma nurses, prescribing clerks, GPs, pharmacists and registered prescribers, so that should a product be required there is a point of reference which will ensure that a standardised approach to prescribing in stoma care is followed.
- The volumes of product and quantities required on a monthly basis have also been included to reduce over prescribing.
- Importantly, any introduction of a new accessory product should always be followed up and reviewed by a Stoma CNS within a relatively short period of time to ensure it has been effective and with a view to discontinuing it. This is part of the East Kent Prescribing Policy.
- Going forward, patient involvement in the review and development of the formulary will be sought via trials and patient focus groups.

Tips for issuing prescriptions

- The formulary applies to new and established stoma patients. Existing stoma patients will be encouraged to change to formulary products at their annual review.
- Not all patients will require an accessory product
- New accessory products **should only** be prescribed following a written recommendation from the Stoma Team (Hospital or Community)
- The Stoma clinical nurse specialist team (Hospital or Community) should only prescribe off formulary, in exceptional clinical circumstances. A rationale will be provided in their recommendation letter.
